This document contains the **Release Notes** for CTE device firmware version **01.10.01**. This version includes feature updates and improvements made after the CTE product firmware 1.09.02 released in September of 2023.

**Installation and Update Notes:**

Device firmware updates are available through the ENGAGE™ cloud database.

From the ENGAGE web portal, each lock may be independently selected by the site administrator to have the latest firmware downloaded during the next scheduled Wi-Fi connection. The site administrator may connect locally to individual devices with the ENGAGE mobile application to update a CTE with the latest firmware.
